



The Kerrville ISD dress code for all campuses is established to teach grooming, hygiene, respect for authority, instill personal discipline, prevent disruption, and to promote learning, modesty, and safety. In general, students should wear clothing that would be appropriate for a job situation.

- Hair must be clean and neatly groomed. Only natural hair colors are acceptable. Hairstyles that are distracting are not acceptable.
- Earrings may be worn only in the ears. No other visible pierced jewelry/decoration is allowed. Earrings/jewelry may not be noisy or distracting.
- Shirts with split sides, crop tops, tank tops, and clothing with spaghetti straps are prohibited.
- Shirts and T-shirts are to be worn appropriately as defined by the campus. Shirts and T-shirts that fall longer than the bottom of a child's seat should be tucked in, regardless of the number of shirts worn.
- The torso of the body must be covered at all times.
- Proper undergarments must be worn at all times, but should not be visible.
- The waistband for pants, shorts, skirts, and skorts must be worn at or above the waistline.
- Pant legs must not drag the ground.
- Spandex shorts as outer garments and cut-offs are prohibited.
- Dresses, skirts, shorts, and skorts must be of modest length, no shorter than the fingertips with arms and hands extended down the sides.
- Oversized/baggy clothing is prohibited. All clothing/outerwear must be of appropriate and acceptable size and length.
- Shoes must be worn. House shoes, and steel-toed boots or shoes are prohibited. Appropriate athletic shoes should be worn during physical education class.
- Transparent clothing and extremely faddish attire are prohibited.
- Caps or other headgear may not be worn on campus during school hours.
- Bandanas may not be worn or carried on campus.
- Chains as part of a wallet or watch or as a visible part of any clothing are prohibited.

- Clothing and/or accessories that are gang-related are prohibited.
- Clothing and/or accessories that advertise or suggest profanity, alcoholic beverages, tobacco, drugs, or violence are prohibited.
- Clothing and/or accessories that contain sexually explicit or suggestive pictures or statements are prohibited.

Students inappropriately dressed will be asked to call home to correct the violation or wear clothing that is provided by the school for the remainder of the day. Repeat offenders may be subject to disciplinary action.

Clarification of these standards rests with campus administration. Campus administration has the right to determine whether a student's dress/grooming is acceptable and appropriate for school.
